**Abstract of the Seminar :**

In recent years, construction work safety has become a growing concern in the construction industry. At the same time, Labour Department continued to step up its inspection and regulatory efforts. Dealing with enforcement actions and prosecution by Labour Department could be quite daunting and challenging. You may wish to know what matters should one be aware of when dealing with investigations by Labour Department and how to defend against industrial summonses issued by Labour Department.

In this seminar, Messrs. Ian Lo and Alfred Lau of ONC Lawyers will share some basic concepts on safety-related legislations in Hong Kong, as well as their experience in dealing with prosecution by Labour Department.

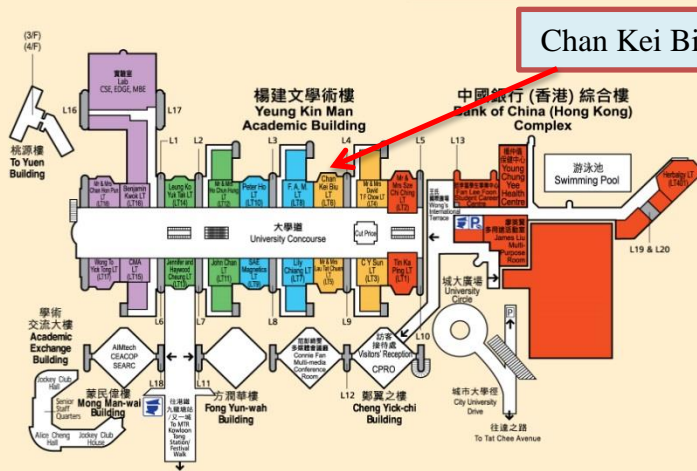
