lain is a civil engineer and has been involved with temporary works design all his career, he has also spent most of his career in HK. He was previously an **Engineering Development Manager in charge of Group Temporary Works with Gammon Construction and is now** with Tony Gee and Partners as the director for business development.



He is the current Chairman of the Hong Kong Temporary Works Forum, a cross industry forum to address the lack of knowledge of temporary works throughout the industry. Iain is a professional member of the HKOSHA and is a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Building and is a chartered construction Manager. He holds the Derek Smythe award for leadership in construction safety and was the Gammon Zero Harm Construction Manager award in 2017.

## **Abstract:**

Temporary Works present the biggest risks in construction. 65% of all deaths are a result of temporary works. Either fall from height from temporary structures of collapse of temporary structures, falsework being the most common.

The presentation will examine the reasons for the need for a temporary works forum and the unacceptable level of death and injuries resulting from the lack of temporary works knowledge on site.

Responsibility for safety in temporary works starts at the design stage and is not solely a site responsibility. Safety also involves the supply chain and the presentation examines the risks in falsework and the lack of knowledge in the supply chain.
