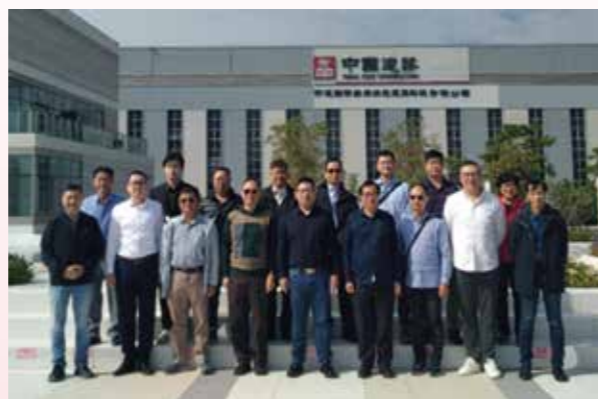

# The 28<sup>th</sup> Cross-Strait, Hong Kong & Macao Occupational Safety & Health Symposium cum Safety Visit at Zhuhai, Mainland China

A group of 18 members participated in the 28th Cross-Strait, Hong Kong and Macao Occupational Safety and Health Symposium cum Safety Visit organized by the HKOSHA on 15–17 November 2023 at Zhuhai, Mainland China. Let me share the 3-day's diary about the symposium and visit.

## Day ONE (15 November)

On the first day of arrival at Zhuhai, HKOSHA arranged a safety visit for us. We received a warm welcome from Mr. YAO Da Wei of China State Construction Hailong Technology Company Limited, who then accompanied with us and introduced a building which is constructed

by Modular Integrated Construction (MiC) method. After that, we went to a factory to appreciate the production of the modular units (the components of a building). Lastly, the world's MiC expert showed us a finished housing estate - Macau New Neighborhood where the pre-cast construction was engaged.

## Day TWO (16 November)

Mr. HE Sheng Zhuang, Chief Officer of Guang Dong Province Emergency Bureau hosted the opening of the symposium and then followed by opening speeches delivered by various honorable guests from different OSH associations including:

- Mr. WANG De Xue, Chairman of China Occupational Safety and Health Association (COSHA)
- Professor WU Qi Ping, Director of Sinosteel Corporation Wuhan Safety & Environmental Protection Research Institute (SEPRI)
- Ms. LIU Bao Jing, Vice-Secretary General of China Association of Work Safety (CAWS);
- Mr. TAN Dao Tong, Chairman of Tapei Industrial Safety and Health Association (ISHA);
- Dr. LAM Chor Yin, Vice-Chairman of the Occupational Safety and Health Council of Hong Kong (OSHC);
- Mr. SUM Tak Yin, President of The Hong Kong Occupational Safety and Health Association (HKOSHA);
- Mr. WONG Chi Hung, Director of Labour Affairs Bureau of Macao SAR;
- Mr. WONG Fai Ming, President of Macau Construction Safety Association (MCSA)

Mr. WANG De Xue of China Occupational Safety and Health Association, as the host of this year's event, delivered the final opening speech. It was strategic, rhythmic and emotionally touching.

After the speeches from honorable guests, several speakers from different districts shared the following OSH topics including:

- Mr. WANG Hau Shui of COSHA presented "The Accident Statistical Report."
- Ms. Bonnie YAU of OSHC addressed the "Heart Caring" Campaign to improve workers' health in Hong Kong.
- Mr. LI Shek Chiu of Macau Labour Affairs Bureau introduced the Six Mind concept.

- Mr. HUANG Jen Ping of ISHA interpreted the accident rates of Taiwan industry while he admired the EU, America and Japan's level of achievement.

Our Vice-President Edward CHOW also shared "The OSH Situation of Hong Kong under the Era of High-Quality Development".

## Day THREE (17 November)

The various presentations of the symposium were conducted in two separate halls on the second day, some presentations are highlighted as follows:

- Ms. CHAN Yuk Ting of Macau Technology University gave her research outcome of Work Related Musculoskeletal Disorders relating the 9 body parts of human bone-pain caused by different kinds of work, work posture, work duration, age and environment.
- Ms. YU Hai Miao of China Mines University gave all the information of miners' problems including health, poverty, group health, mental stress, family stress and old age diseases. We can call it an overall understanding and appraisal of miners.
- Senior Consultant of Hong Kong OSHC Ms. YU Hoi Guen shared a programme about joyful and healthy workplace for the fat workers. The programme consists of three elements namely "activity", "mental health" and "healthy food" engaged by fat workers. Awards of "Healthy Eaters" and "No-reason 2-day Leave" were provided in the programme.
- Ms. Bak Lo Chik of Macau Technology University presented his research of factors leading to hearing loss.
- Ms. XIAO Meng Ji of China Steel Group analyzed on liquid CO2 hazards of a recycling industry and she provided control measures to reduce the hazards.
- Mr. SZE Dong Leung of Macau Office Work Association investigated the occupational health of office workers, recommending the need of training and OSH technology.

- Ms. LO Choi Tung of OSHC addressed the increasing "trip and fall" accidents and she emphasized on the training of multi-tasks capability to workers. A "12-week Fall Prevention Programme" was recommended.
- Ms. LIU Xian Wei of a Wu Han company proclaimed the case of a stem cell therapy to all parts of human body and its capability of repairing damaged cells in human body.

The Symposium was successfully concluded with a wrap-up meeting by key representatives of various OSH associations. It was decided that next year's Symposium would be hosted by Sinosteel Wuhan Safety & Environmental Protection Research Institute (Sinosteel SEPRI) in September at Harbin, Mainland China.

This Symposium, after the pandemic, was somewhat a short one to resume such event. Although not many faces of old friends were seen, faces of new youngsters were appeared. This was a good sign and atmosphere of changes that more young generation entered the field of OSH profession.

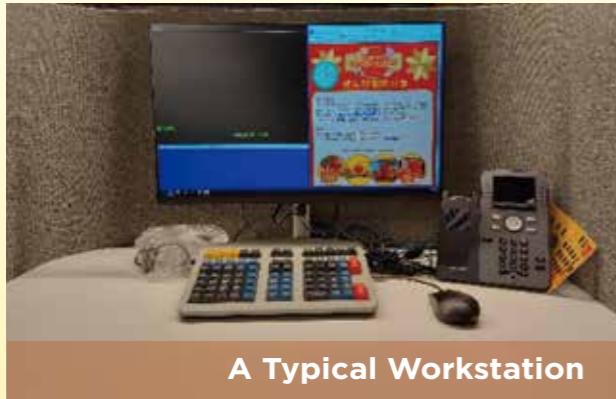

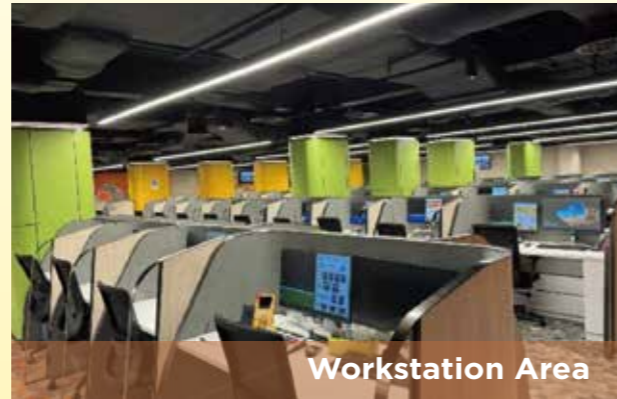


Souvenir Presentation
